Jurate Hardy, Ros Balodis, Leanne Swaysland, Brenda Foster and the Evans brothers, Michael and Greg all collected gold medals.

Jurate Hardy from Melbourne, Victoria is our only gold medalist in the singles at the Individual Championships. Jurate, the number 3 seed defeated the number 2 seed, Isabelle Tyrell (Great Britain) 6/0, 6/2. Jurate has been living overseas for the past three years.

In the Womens 55+ Doubles, Ros Balodis and Leanne Swaysland won their semi-final 6/0, 6/0 against Tracy Houk and Judy Newman (USA). In the other semi-final, Brenda Foster and Christine French (GBR) won their tight semi 6/1, 4/6, 6/3 against Ingrid Gutmann-Resch and Lisalot Prechtel-Koot (No 1 seed). 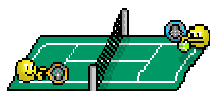
