2015 AUSTRALIAN TEAMS CARNIVAL—CANBERRA— 5 to 9 January

Join us for a week of competitive yet social tennis at the Australian Teams Carnival 2015. Play at the newly redeveloped National Sports Club Lyneham and other tennis clubs around the nation’s capital. You can enter a team with your friends or nominate individually through your State. Teams are subject to State Selectors approval.

There will be social events during the week of the Teams event and these include an Opening Ceremony and Welcome on Sunday 4 January and Presentation Dinner Dance after Teams week on Friday 9 January. A State Dinner for all Queensland players will be held on Monday night after the first day’s play and is a great opportunity for a get-together of all players.

State Queensland uniform is required to be worn during the Teams event. This consists of Qld shirt and Qld shorts for men and Qld shirt and Qld skirt for women. An order form will be forwarded to new nominees on receipt of their nomination.

Team nomination covers your tennis for the week of the Teams event. You will be required to be a member of Tennis Seniors Queensland and the 2015 annual fee of \$20.00 **must** be paid with your nomination. There is no longer a fee for Tennis Queensland membership but as a member of Tennis Seniors Queensland, you will then be registered with Tennis Queensland and this will mean you are covered by Personal Accident Insurance provided by MYTENNIS .
