Celebrating world championships success

Tennis Seniors Australia congratulates all players who represented Australia in Turkey over the past few weeks in the World Teams Championships and in the World Individual Championships.

Some notable successes were achieved in the World Individual Championships.

Brendon Moore won the Men's 35-39 World Championship and did not lose a singles match over the two-week period. The final featured a close first set with a tie-break win to Brendan, followed by a comprehensive 6-0 second set to earn Australia its first world title in this age group for many years.

Allen Belobrajdic was runner up in the Men's 45-49 year age group, reaching the final with some strong victories. His Spanish conqueror in the final had won many past World Championships, so was very experienced in this environment and won the final 6-1 6-1.

In doubles, Iggy Jovanovic and Jarrod Broadbent brought home the 50-54 title, dropping only 15 games over 4 matches. They won the final 6-2 6-1 over the top-seeded German pair.

In another notable result, Jaimie Swift won the women's 40-44 consolation final.
