



AUSTRALIAN MASTERS TEAM SELECTION CHAIR

ROLE OVERVIEW

The Selection Chair is the key link between Tennis Seniors Australia (TSA), Tennis Australia (TA) and the selection committee. They will liaise via the TA/TSA Teams Administrators.

There will usually be two selection chairs, one each for men and women's teams. These are annual appointments by the TA/TSA Executive.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Organising and chairing Selectors Meetings in accordance with a schedule agreed with the TSA/TA Teams Administrators.
- Liaison with the TA/TSA Teams Administrators on any issues raised at the selection committee meetings if agreement cannot be reached.
- Administering the TA/TSA selection policy and assisting other selectors to correctly interpret the policy.
- Ensuring that the outcomes of selection meetings are agreed by all selectors, based on unanimity, consensus or at least a majority view (note that the Chair does not have a casting vote).
- Forward team selections to the Team Administrators. This includes preparing a summary report that outlines the basis for decisions made during the selection process, and providing further information about the basis of decisions to the TA/TSA Teams Administrators upon request.
- Providing a response to any queries arising from players regarding selections, in consultation with the TSA/TA Teams Administrator.
