

A memo from TENNIS VETERANS AUSTRALIA contains the following information:

We have been advised by the International Tennis Federation, that immediately, "ITF Vets" will be re-branded as "ITF Seniors".

- The ITF Seniors Committee feel that ITF Seniors is a more international term and will enable the ITF to better promote, market and develop the very popular area of Seniors Tennis throughout the world. The terms Seniors and Super-Seniors will be used to distinguish the split in age groups, 35-55 and 60-85 respectively. The following titles will now be used: ITF Seniors World Individual Championships; ITF Seniors World Team Championships; ITF Super-Seniors World Individual Championships and ITF Super-Seniors World Team Championships.
- At this time Tennis Vets Australia has not made any decision to change our name, so we will continue to use the title "Vets" for the immediate future.
- It has now been agreed with the ITF that the 2005 ITF Group 'A' Events (Player ages 35-55, now to be known as the ITF Senior World Individual and Team Championships) will be held in Perth, Western Australia from Sunday 27 March to Saturday 9 april, 2005. The administration venue and major playing location will be at Robertson Park in North Perth.
- The dates for our 2005 Australian Vets Championships to be played in Newcastle, New South Wales remain unchanged—being from Sunday 10 April to Friday 22 April.
- Please note that the next Annual General Meeting of Tennis Vets Australia will be held in Newcastle, New South Wales on Tuesday, 12 April, 2005.
- At the President's Meeting held in Sydney recently, a number of changes were approved to our National Selection Criteria and these will be published by the middle of July. Nominations for selection for the ITF Group 'A' Events (ITF Seniors) will be called for at the end of July, with nominations closing at the end of October, 2004. It is expected that selections will be conducted in November and teams announced by the end of that month. The ITF's Group 'B' Events (ITF Super-Seniors) will be played in Turkey in October, 2005 and our national selections will be completed at the end of our Australian Championships in Newcastle next April.
- The Divisional Presidents have agreed that the 2006 Australian Vets Championships will be held in Christchurch, New Zealand from Sunday 8 January to Friday 20 January, 2006. This innovative scheduling is seen as a timely proposal to provide interesting tourist opportunities for all players... and an opportunity to cement our relationships with our New Zealand Veteran friends.
