VALE - IVY HAM

31/8/1914 to 22/4/2004

With the passing of Ivy Ham, Queensland tennis has lost one of its most distinguished and dedicated workers.

For decades, the name "Ivy Ham" was synonymous with tennis in Brisbane. Ivy was elected to the Management Committee of Saturday afternoon fixtures on 16 October, 1961 to fill a casual vacancy and stayed for the next 36 years, retiring at the annual general meeting held on 24 November, 1997.

Ivy served in the position of Honorary Secretary for an amazing 32 continuous years. She was also a Vice President from 1978 to 1997. She was elected to Honorary Life Membership in 1974.

At a time when tennis is struggling because of the shortage of community-minded players who are willing to help organize their own sport, Ivy's contribution has been without equal.

It must not be forgotten that at the same time she served as a Councillor (26/2/62 to 17/5/1997) and Director (26/4/84 to 31/5/1990) of Tennis Queensland amd President of the Suburban Ladies Midweek Tennis Association. Ivy had the distinction of being the first woman to be a Director of Tennis Queensland (and the first woman to hold the position of Vice-President).

Ivy was Honorary Treasurer of Queensland Veterans Tennis Association from 1974 to 1977 and Secretary/Treasurer from 1978 to 1979 and again from 1985 to 1997.

Ivy's outstanding contribution; to the game of tennis was recognized by Tennis Queensland in 1988 with a short biography in "The Administrators" section of its centennial book, "A Century of Queensland Tennis".

In 1993 she was presented with the Geoffrey E Griffith Order of Merit Award and in 1998 with Honorary Life Membership of Tennis Queensland. In September 2000, Ivy was awarded an Australian Sports Medal of which she was very proud.

GOLDMAN CUP-International 90s Tennis Team Match-USA vs World

This event was held in Palm Springs, California where Bill Rogers (Toowoomba, Qld) captained the World team and was No 1 seed in the Goldman Cup for 90 year olds. He then competed in the USTA Hardcourt Championships for 90 year olds. This drew 20 entries and is an ITF and USTA Ranking event.

The Goldman Cup was held for the first time and was an outstanding success. It wasn't an ITF event but in the eyes of both players and spectators, it was "big-time". The matches were played on hard courts at Palm Springs Tennis Club and Bill was not accustomed to the courts. He met the No 1 seed from America, Dave Carey, in his singles and won the first set 6/3 but went down 6/3 6/4 in the next two sets. It was a great match and the crowd were delighted with both players. Next day in the doubles, Bill and his No 5 player met the American No 1 and No 2 and they were successful in straight sets. B Rogers & G Hunger defeated Dave Carey & Bill Lurie 6/1 6/4. Sweet revenge.

The expenses for all players in this event were covered and they were all housed in a resort. Bill will be playing with one of the German players in the European Championships later in the month. This person has won more European Championships than any other person, so Bill has been fortunate in gaining an experienced partner.

At the end of May, Bill and wife Joan are embarking on a round-the-world tour for 4 months. They will visit Munich, Berlin, Portschach for the Austrian and European Championships. Then fly to Atlanta for 2 months to stay with friends and get in some practice before playing in Boston in the USTA Grass Championships. Next they go to Pinehurst for USTA Clay and to Philadelphia for the World Championships. The 90's aren't official there but the only way to get them official is to support them. It is expected that there will be 90 Years ITF Rankings, so that's an added incentive to Bill.

Many thanks to Joan Rogers for this information and it is nice to know that we have an Aussie and a Queenslander at that, flying the flag on the International Vets scene. Best of luck, Bill.
