## PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2004-5

As we review the year that has passed it is pleasing to report that this association continues to meet the needs of senior tennis players in this State and through the network of clubs and associations is achieving our stated aim of:

Creating a friendly and sociable atmosphere for any player who is aged 35 or over through the promotion of veterans tennis, and the encouragement of veterans tennis tournaments throughout Oueensland

Queensland still has the largest number of veteran tennis players in Australia and with over 25% of the membership of Tennis Veterans Australia, our association is the envy of many of the other states.

## Highlights of the year are:

## 2005 Australian Tennis Vets Championships

The venue for the Australian Tennis Veterans Championships for 2005 was Newcastle with team events from 11-15th April, 2005 and the individual events 17-22nd April, 2005. This was an attempt by New South Wales to move the championships away from the heat of January, and whilst the playing conditions were better it did preclude the participation of some from the younger age group.

Queensland was represented by twenty five teams and I would like to thank all those who participated in this annual event. New South Wales was the overall winner of the teams event, whilst several of our teams were successful in their age group. The Opening Ceremony at the Basketball Stadium was very entertaining and the young talent on display was appreciated by all the players.

In recent years a Queensland State Dinner has been introduced and because of its popularity the calculation of numbers has become a problem for caterers and in future it will be necessary to have confirmed bookings and payment prior to the evening.

# NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED $30^{\mathrm{TH}}$ JUNE, 2005

### 1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

These financial statements are a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act Queensland. The Committee has determined that the Committee is not a reporting entity.

The statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act Queensland and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

AAS 1: Profit and Loss Accounts

AAS 4: Depreciation of non-Current Assets

AAS 5: Materiality

AAS 8: Events Occurring After Reporting Date

No other Australian Accounting Standards or mandatory professional reporting requirements have been applied.

The statements are also prepared on an accruals basis. They are based on historic costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of these statements:

## (a) Income Tax

The Association is exempt from the payment of income tax to the Commonwealth Government under Section 23 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1936, being a sporting body constituted under the Association Incorporation Act, Queensland.

## (b) Property, Plant & Equipment

Property, Plant and Equipment are brought to account at cost, less any applicable accumulated depreciation or amortisation. The carrying amount is reviewed annually by the management committee to ensure it is not in excess of the recoverable amount from those assets. The recoverable amount is assessed on the basis as expected net cash flows which will be received from the assets employment and subsequent disposal. The expected net cash flows have not been discounted to their present values in determining the recoverable amount. The depreciable amount of all fixed assets other than freehold land are depreciated over the useful lives commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

# INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF THE TENNIS VETERANS QUEENSLAND ASSOCIATION INC

### Scope

I have audited the financial statements of the Tennis Veterans Queensland Assoc Inc for the year ended 30th June, 2005 being a special purpose financial report consisting of the profit and loss account, balance sheet and accompanying notes set out on pages 6-7.

The Management Committee are responsible for the financial statements. The Management Committee has determined that the accounting policies used and described in Note 1 to the financial statements are appropriate to meet the needs of the members. I have conducted an independent audit of the financial statements in order to express an opinion on them to the members of the association. No opinion is expressed as to whether the accounting policies used are appropriate to the needs of the members.

The financial statements have been prepared for distribution to the members. I disclaim any assumption of responsibility for any reliance on this report, or on the financial statements to which it related, to any person other than the members, or for any purpose other than that for which it was prepared.

My audit has been conducted with the Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. My+A48 procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial statements, and the evaluation of significant accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion whether, in all material respects, the financial statements are presented fairly in accordance with the basis of accounting described in Note 1 to the financial statements. These policies do not require the application of all Accounting Standards or other mandatory professional reporting requirements.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

#### Qualification

Completeness of revenue

As is common for organizations of this type, it is not practicable for the Club to maintain an effective system of internal control over fees,

donations, subscriptions and other fund-raising activities until their initial entry into the accounting records. Accordingly, my audit in relation to these items was limited to amounts recorded.

Qualified Audit Opinion.

In my opinion, except for the effects of such adjustments, if any, that might have been determined to be necessary, had the limitation discussed in the qualification paragraph not existed, the financial report presents fairly in accordance with

applicable Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional requirements, the financial position of the Tennis Veterans Queensland Assoc Inc as at 30th June 2005 and the results of its operations for the year then ended.

#### DISCLAIMER

The additional financial information presented on pages 5 and 6 is in accordance with the books and records of the Tennis Veterans Queensland Assoc Inc which have been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in my statutory audit of the association for the year ended 30 June, 2005. It will be appreciated that my statutory audit did not cover all details of the additional financial information. Accordingly I do not express an opinion on such financial information and no warranty of accuracy or reliability is given. In accordance with this policy I further advise that I accept no responsibility arising in an way whatsoever to any parson (other than the Club) in respect of

such information, including any errors or omissions therein, arising through negligence or otherwise however caused.
