## RESULTS 2007 AUSTRALIAN TENNIS SENIORS CHAMPIONSHIPS—PERTH WA 7-19 JANUARY

Once again VICTORIA has won the Teams Event at this Championships—congratulations.

The winning Division is decided by the best percentage (%) of sets won and credited against sets <u>played and credited</u> during the round robin matches by all teams from that Division, including all playoff finals. Actual match points (as distinct from set points) awarded in the minor round matches are NOT to be counted.

This system is currently under review as there is a school of thought that the actual match points (as distinct from set points) should be counted in the overall total. Each Division/State has been asked to conduct their own review and forward a formal reply to Tennis Seniors Australia by end of March, 2007. The Queensland teams who participated in Perth will be contacted for their input. If any members who did not go to Perth have an opinion on the matter, please contact Secretary, Coral.
