#### **Tournament Conditions**

- 1. This Tournament is sanctioned by Tennis ACT and approved by ITF and TVA and shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of the game adopted by ITF and Tennis Australia.
- 2. The Tournament Committee shall have the entire control of the tournament and reserves the right to make such changes and decisions considered necessary for the management of the tournament.
  - Should any dispute arise on matters not included in the conditions, and not left specifically to the Referee, the matter shall be referred to the Tournament Director whose decision shall be final.
- 3. Doubles competitors are expected to enter with partners. If a partner is not nominated, the Tournament Committee will endeavor to locate one but will not guarantee to do so. Partners as allocated must be accepted.
- 4. Each competitor must submit an entry form accompanied with fees and their signed Player Agreement and Release Form. No player will be entered into the draw until the entry fee and signed Player Agreement and Release Form has been received. No refunds will be given after the draw has been made.
- 5. Championship Events 1 40 will be conducted as 'Knock Out' events and shall be the best of 3 tie break sets. For the Singles Events a rest period, not exceeding 10 minutes, may be taken at the end of the second set.
- 6. Non Championship Events 41 49, and Special Events 50 52 will be played as a 10 game 'Round Robin' events with a tie-break at 5 all. The winner of the tie-break shall receive 5 games with a winners notation attached which shall be used in determining the overall winner in the event of a tie.
- 7. The Non Championship Round Robin Women's Singles event will be played as detailed in the 'NOTES' alongside the Schedule Of Events.
- 8. Should entries in any event be fewer than 8, the Tournament Committee may combine that event with the next age group or play it as a round robin event if previously indicated as a 'Knock Out' Event.
- 9. All competitors are guaranteed two matches in the events they have entered. A Compass Draw, Consolation or Feed In events will be conducted to provide the 2<sup>nd</sup> match for players losing their first round matches in the knock out events. Byes are not deemed 'a match', but Walkovers and Forfeits are deemed matches.
- 10. If the number of entries received in a Singles Event(s) exceeds 16 then play in those events may be necessary on Thursday afternoon 9<sup>th</sup> April. In the event of this occurring, the required competitors will be notified by the 3<sup>rd</sup> April.
- 11. In normal circumstances events will be played during the time slots listed in the 'NOTES' alongside the Schedule Of Events.
  - However, if made necessary by weather or other causes, matches maybe drawn outside their regular timeslots or under lights. It is the player's responsibility to check the draw, ascertain his/her time for each match and be ready to play at least fifteen (15) minutes before his/her scheduled time of play, irrespective of weather conditions.
- 12. Regulation Tennis attire must be worn. Shoes with barred, studded or rippled soles will not be permitted.
- 13. Head tennis balls will be used exclusively for the tournament.
