TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- 1. The tournament will be conducted under the rules of Tennis Qld and TSQ rules and guidelines for the conduct of Seniors Round Robin Tournaments and The Tennis Australia & Member Association Events Disciplinary Policy.
- 2. The Tournament Management Committee, hereinafter referred to as the "Committee" shall have the entire control and management of the Tournament. Any matter not specifically covered by these conditions shall be resolved by the Committee, whose decision shall be final.
- 3. All Queensland resident competitors must be registered members of Tennis Queensland and Tennis Seniors Queensland or their equivalent State or National bodies. **Special Condition**: Senior Players who are **from an INTERSTATE** Club, **MUST** pay a temporary membership fee of **\$10.00** for this tournament **ONLY**.
- 4. All events will be round robin, consisting of a one tie-break set. The Committee reserves the right to apply the No Ad rule, to cancel, amalgamate, or divide into sections, events if deemed necessary.
- 5. All players must submit a separate entry form accompanied by fees and sign the Player Agreement and Release Statement. **No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees**. Phone/Fax/Email entries will not be accepted. Late entries will not be accepted. No refunds will be given after the draw has been made.
- 6. This Tournament is open to all players who are 35 years and over. Players must be the correct age by the end of the current year.
- 7. Play must commence on time: 8.00am for morning sessions, 1.00pm for afternoon sessions.
- 8. Hit-ups 3 minutes, one hit-up only per player, per session.
- 9. No morning matches/finals to commence after 12.30pm. Any morning matches/finals not completed will be played at completion of afternoon matches on the same day under lights if necessary.
- 10. A competitor entering for a doubles event without naming a partner, shall accept the partner allotted by the committee. This condition shall not impose any obligation on the committee to find a partner.
- 11. Players entering must play as often as required on the same day and under lights. Participants may be asked to travel to outside courts.
- 12. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to regrade players after the first event if they are found to be too strong for "B" section.
- 13. Umpires will be provided for court play offs, if requested.
- 14. The decision of the referee must be adhered to.
- 15. **Winners Formula: SETS WON**, if equal-games won, if equal-games against, if equal-winner when the pairs played.
- 16. **Forfeits:** If a pair forfeit during a session, the score for all sets already played will stand, and all unplayed sets against the forfeiting pair will be recorded as zero.
- 17. Trophies will be given for all winners and runners-up.
