Her other tournaments during the year included ITF State Seniors Championships in July and ITF Sunshine Coast Championships in September. At the 2010 Annual General Meeting, Gail was also awarded a Life Membership of Tennis Seniors Queensland for her services to Seniors tennis.

Congratulations to Dr Charles Roe, was the recipient of an Australia Day Award this year.

MEMBER (AM) IN THE GENERAL DIVISION OF THE ORDER OF AUSTRALIA.

He has just reached his 92 birthday on February 12 this year. The Award was for service to medicine, particularly through contributions to the Australian Medical Association Queensland, and to the community. His credentials are listed here:

Designated Aviation Medical Examiner, Civil Aviation Safety Authority, 1946-2003.

Wing Commander and consultant urologist/venereologist, Royal Australian Air Force, 1947-1980; Medical Administrator, 1946-1958; WWII Medical Officer, No 76 Fighter Squadron, 1943-1946; Mentioned in Despatches, 1944.

Member, Mental Health Review Tribunal, 1975-1989; Advisory role, Queensland Medical Assessment Tribunal, 1975-1989; Former Member, State Executive, Medical Benefits Fund; Former Member, State Medical Planning Committee; Member, Patient Review Tribunal, 1974-1989; Fellow, Royal Australian College of Surgeons, 1977; Member, Urological Society of Australia, for many years.

Board Chairman, Classical Radio 4MBS, Brisbane for 2 years; program developer and announcer, for several years.

Member, Administrative Board, Brisbane Forest Park for 10 years.

Involved, Australian Veterans Tennis Championships until 2004 and then in 2010 and 2011.

Charles, one of our Super-Senior players, was Captain of Queensland Mens 75/2 team in Newcastle and is still actively playing tennis regularly on Gold Coast.

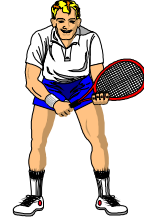
