<u>UPDATE FROM THE TSA EXECUTIVE—AUGUST 2012</u> CHANGES TO THE AUSTRALIAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS.

AUGUST/SEPTEMBER NEWSLEITER

Following a survey of players and discussions between the Divisional Presidents, Divisional Secretaries and the Executive, the following has been agreed:

- The Australian Teams Championships will now be called Australian Teams Carnival
- January will be retained for the playing of the Carnival
- There will be no reduction to the current 5 playing days.
- Teams will be programmed to play 8 matches if possible
- Teams are encouraged to have 5/6 players.

(Note: A proposal for a 3 person team for some of the older age groups has been rejected.)

- Teams shall only use a maximum of 6 players per match.
- The 'two six game set' format will be retained
- A 'bye' will be programmed if possible.
- Match Times have been revised to: 08:00-10:30 10:40-13:10 13:20-15:50 16:00-18:30
- The playing format for 6 teams will be finalised after teams have been received and allocated to Divisions. Every endeavour will be made to avoid the situation where teams have to play each other 3 times.
- Finals will be played for all age groups.
- Finals will be played on Friday with the opportunity for unsuccessful teams to watch the finals.
- The 10 year age bracket will be retained for 2013 and reviewed annually. The Review will include numbers participating and the accuracy of player ratings.

ITF PROCEDURES

If players go to the <u>92computing.com.au</u> website, you will be able view the **entry procedures for the Australian Individual Championships.** You will notice you need an ITF IPIN to enter the Championships and you will notice you need to enter on <u>both</u> the ITF IPIN site and the 92computing website. There are links to take you to the registration for IPIN site and to take you to the ITF IPIN site to lodge your entry with the ITF.

CLOSING DATE FOR THE AUSTRALIAN INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Due to changes in ITF procedures and to coordinate our closing date with the ITF closing date, the closing date is now changed to **December 26th, 2012**. We will be using the 19 day closing option of the ITF as a result of further changes negotiated with the ITF.

NOMINATIONS FOR AUSTRALIAN TEAMS FOR THE 2013 ITF CUPS

Players can now nominate for the ITF Cups teams. Seniors have until Sunday, October 14th, 2012 to nominate for teams for the Seniors World Team Championships to be held in Turkey. The Selection Criteria will be used for all players nominating for teams. Nominations for Super-Senior Teams in the Czech Republic and Austria will close on Sunday, March 17th, 2013 after the staging of the Australian Claycourt Championships at Kooyong, Melbourne.

2012 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of Tennis Seniors Queensland will be held during the Tewantin tournament on Sunday 23 September 2012 at Tewantin Tennis Club. As this is an important meeting to make

changes to the Constitution as listed in the document sent to all Affiliated Clubs, it is essential that we have a representative of each Affiliated Club present. If a Club cannot attend the meeting, they may nominate a member to represent their Club at the AGM by phoning Coral on 3349 4339 or by completing the Ballot Paper to register their vote and return it to Coral before the meeting. Nominations have been called for Queensland Selectors, 3 men and 3 women—in age groups 35 to 45; 50 to 60 and 65 and over. Appointment of Selectors will be decided by the Management Committee from the nominations received and announced at the Annual General Meeting.

A REMINDER ABOUT YOUR IPIN



About 1000 Australian senior players have now registered for an IPIN, allowing them to enter any ITF sanctioned tournament anywhere in the world. As many would know, IPIN was free until 31st October 2011 and if you registered before this date, your IPIN is valid until the end of 2012. If you apply now, the cost is US\$20, which will increase to US\$30 in 2013. If you wish to apply now for an IPIN, go to www.itftennis.com click on "Explore the ITF" and then go to IPIN. You can then follow the prompts and pay by credit card.

Just another reminder, that if you play one only (i.e. not more than one) ITF event in 2012, be it singles or doubles, your IPIN will be **free for 2013**. So there may be a benefit for some who do not have an IPIN to take advantage of the current lower cost (and the strong Australian dollar) and then play one ITF event before year end.

The ITF have not yet advised us as to how the charge for your IPIN for 2013 will be raised and what the payment mechanism will be. As soon as we have this information, the States will be advised.

'ADOPT A FRIEND AND HELP A FRIEND'

Last year to assist players who did not have an email address the 'ADOPT A FRIEND AND HELP A FRIEND' promotion was instigated. This was quite successful and it has been decided to continue with the following promotion again this year as there are always players without an email address who would like to play ITF tournaments.

Because a unique email address is required to apply for a ITF IPIN and because there are many players without an email address, **please help a player in need by obtaining a free email address** for him or her. If we can find around a hundred persons to assist in this project, we could each help a player to obtain a free email address. By doing this, we can spread the load within our Association. To obtain a free email address, go to google.com, click on gmail and follow the links to create a free email address. Players without an email address are asked to identify themselves to a friend to assist with the obtaining of an email address and the registration of a IPIN. Registration for a IPIN will cost US\$20.00 up until 31st Dec 2012 after which it will cost US\$30.00. Your help will be appreciated.

ENTERING ON-LINE FOR ITF TOURNAMENTS IN AUSTRALIA

The TSA Executive would like to remind ALL players of their responsibilities when entering ITF tournaments in Australia. If players are entering an ITF event, for singles, doubles or mixed, you **MUST** enter on-line at www.itftennis.com/ipin **for the IPIN events**, as well as www.92computing.com.au **for ALL events** and for payment of your entry fees before the closing date.

Check the tournament entry form to see what events will be conducted as **ITF IPIN** events before entering. Players entering in **IPIN** events **MUST** have an **IPIN**.

Closing dates shown on the entry form and **ITF IPIN** website will be strictly enforced for **ALL ITF** events. Please ensure you do not leave your on-line entry until the last moment in case you experience any problems with your entry. In Qld we have had players entering on the last day only to find they need an IPIN and some have not had an email address either. The race is then on to obtain an email address and register for IPIN before entries close on that day.

In Qld players will only need IPIN to enter **singles events** in our three ITF Tournaments. For further information on registering for IPIN, please visit www.itftennis.com/seniors.

2012 TSQ CLAYCOURT CHAMPIONSHIPS-10-13 August


