## Tournament Conditions

1. This Tournament is sanctioned by Tennis ACT and approved by ITF and TSA and shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of the game adopted by ITF and Tennis Australia.
2. The Tournament Committee shall have the entire control of the tournament and reserves the right to make such changes and decisions considered necessary for the management of the tournament.

Should any dispute arise on matters not included in the conditions, and not left specifically to the Referee, the matter shall be referred to the Tournament Director whose decision shall be final.
3. Doubles competitors are expected to enter with partners. If a partner is not nominated, the Tournament Committee will endeavor to locate one but will not guarantee to do so. Partners as allocated must be accepted.
4. Each competitor must submit an entry form accompanied with fees and their signed Player Agreement and Release Form. No player will be entered into the draw until the entry fee and signed Player Agreement and Release Form has been received. No refunds will be given after the draw has been made.
5. Part of your entry fee includes a " user pays" levy that will be paid to Tennis Seniors Australia.
6. Players entering the IPIN events are required to enter online at: www.itftennis.com/ipin and www. 92 computing.com.au. These players must enter on BOTH Websites

Players entering the NON-IPIN events are only required to enter online at www.92computing.com.au
7. Competitors must be over the Event age as at 31 December 2013.
8. Championship Events $1-19$ will be conducted as 'Knock - Out' events and shall be the best of 3 tie break sets. A rest period, not exceeding 10 minutes, may be taken at the end of the second set.

NON-IPIN Events $49-82$ will be conducted as 'Round Robin' events. The number of games played per match will be determined by the number of entries in the event.

The NON-IPIN Round Robin Women's Singles event will be played as detailed alongside the Event
The Seniors ITF tie-break rule will be used during the tournament, play one point and change ends and then change after every four points.
9. Should entries in the IPIN events be fewer than 8 , the Tournament Committee may combine that event with the next age group or play it as a round robin event.
10. All first round losers are eligible for another match. Consolation events for players losing their first round singles matches will be conducted to provide the $2^{\text {nd }}$ match but is dependant upon player entries. Doubles/mixed pairs losing their first round match are eligible to play in the following days NON-IPIN round robin events. Byes are not deemed 'a match', but Walkovers and Forfeits are deemed matches. It is the responsibility of the player to enter the Consolation and NON-IPIN events.
11. If the number of entries received in a Singles Event(s) exceeds 16 then matches in those events may be played 4:00 pm on Thursday $28^{\text {th }}$ March. In the event of this occurring, the required competitors will be notified by the $26^{\text {th }}$ March. Alternatively two matches may be played on Friday $29^{\text {th }}$ March.
12. The time draw will be displayed on Tuesday $26^{\text {th }}$ March at the Weston Creek Tennis Club and on the website www.92computing.com.au If made necessary by weather or other causes, some matches may be played under lights. It is the player's responsibility to check the draw, ascertain his/her time for each match and be ready to play at least fifteen (15) minutes before his/her scheduled time of play, irrespective of weather conditions.
13. Regulation Tennis attire must be worn. Shoes with barred, studded or rippled soles will not be permitted.
14. Head tennis balls will be used exclusively for the tournament.
