

## 2024 TSQ REQUIREMENTS & CRITERIA FOR SENIORS TOURNAMENTS.

All Seniors round robin tournaments held in Queensland must be affiliated clubs/associations of Tennis Queensland and **must** be sanctioned by Tennis Qld & approved by Tennis Seniors Qld Inc and conducted in accordance with the TSQ Regulations and Guidelines for the conduct of Seniors Round Robin Tournaments and TA's Member Protection By-law and TA's Code of Behaviour.

- TSQ Guidelines are available on TSQ website at <u>www.tennisseniors.org.au/qld</u> click on "Tournaments" then "Tournament Resources".
- All Senior & National Ranking Tournaments MUST use the TA TP (Tournament Planner) program.
   Senior events must be offered in 5 year age brackets to retain a TSA NRT status, this is a requirement of TSA. All tournaments must use the online entry system in TP.
- Tournament Entry: Entries should open on the TA tournaments website at least 5-6 weeks prior to the commencement of the tournament. Tournaments must use the TP backup file that they are sent, otherwise they will be unable to publish the tournament. Fact Sheets & Entry Forms MUST be approved by TSQ six weeks prior to the commencement of the tournament. The 30+Seniors/TSQ lock up logo must appear on all entry forms. (Entry Form Templates are available on the TSQ website do not update last year's entry form as there may be changes to the rules & regulations) If your tournament is a TSA National Ranking Event, advertise this on the front page of your entry form, (i.e. TSA National Ranking Tournament Nat.6). After approval by TSQ, the entry form will be published on the TSQ website.
- Close of Entries: A TP backup MUST to be forwarded to the TSQ Secretary Reg Baxter, as soon as
  possible after close of entries E: tsq.tennis@bigpond.com to identify new memberships. The current
  Membership List is available on the TSQ website click on "Membership" and then "Are you already a
  Financial Member".
- **Seedings:** If required, the Tournament Director should contact TSQ by email <a href="mailto:tsq.tennis@bigpond.com">tsq.tennis@bigpond.com</a> requesting assistance with seedings. The Tennis Seniors Australia Singles and Doubles Rankings may be used as a guide for seeding purposes.
- TSQ Fees and Collection: 2024 Tennis Seniors Qld membership fee is \$20.00. All Qld Resident Senior Tournament players MUST be members of TSQ to be eligible to compete in a seniors tournament. Each body conducting a Seniors Tournament is required to collect the TSQ fees for all new members.
- **Special Condition**: Players who are only going to play one tournament this year and are financial members of the club conducting the tournament may pay a **once only** tournament levy of \$10.00 for the tournament. However, if a player plays another seniors tournament in 2024, they will be required to pay another \$10.00 to receive full TSQ membership fee. (**Please make sure your members are aware of this Regulation**). Players from **other states/countries**, who are **NOT** full members of a recognised Senior Club/Assoc, **MUST** pay a temporary tournament levy of \$10.00 for this tournament **ONLY**. The non-member temporary \$10.00 levy from other states/countries may be retained by the tournament.

- Personal Accident Insurance: All TSQ members are covered.
- Tournaments using the TP online entry facility a % of the fees are deducted, should charge \$22.00 for the TSQ fee to cover the deduction. The amount of \$20.00 per membership MUST be passed onto TSQ.

All TSQ fees must be forwarded as soon as possible after the completion of your tournament, along with the \$10.00 Tournament Levy for the once only tournament players from your club. Preferably by **EFT to BSB 638-070 A/c 7014953**. Cheques may be posted to the TSQ Secretary, Reg Baxter, 118/242 Parklands Blvd, Meridan Plains. 4551.

- Completion of Tournament: A TP backup of your tournament must be forwarded to TSQ Secretary
  Reg Baxter, within 7 days of the completion of your tournament E: <a href="mailto:tsq.tennis@bigpond.com">tsq.tennis@bigpond.com</a> and must
  include all scores, plus all players information, also to the TSA Rankings Coordinator, Gail Bates at
  <a href="mailto:maxgailbates@bigpond.com">maxgailbates@bigpond.com</a>
- Tennis ID Number: All players must have a Tennis ID Number (66333xxxxxxx) this number must be linked to the UTR. Players who do not have a Tennis ID must acquire one by going to TA Match Centre and creating an account.
- TSQ collate Qld Seniors Tournament information for TQ. There is a TQ tournament application fee and sanction fees of \$2.20 per player per event this will be invoiced to you by TQ and must be paid on receipt of the invoice.
- Subsidy Scheme: TSQ have a subsidy scheme for all sanctioned senior tournaments conducted by an affiliated seniors club. A subsidy payment will be forwarded to the relevant Club, after all the above criteria has been met. Clubs who are **not affiliated** with TSQ may become affiliated with TSQ for \$50 per annum and be eligible for the subsidy.
- **Subsidy amounts are**: Up to 50 entrants \$150; 51-100 entrants \$200; 101-150 entrants \$250; 151-200 entrants \$300; 201-250 entrants \$350; 251-300++ entrants \$400.
